**Graphic Summary of Medical Malpractice Incidence and Cost for Delaware from 2003-2014** 




Figure 1: Total number of Paid Medical Malpractice Claims for Delaware from 2003-2014 for All Health Care Practitioners Combined as Well as for MD/DOs Only





Figure 2: Total Amount Paid for All Medical Malpractice Claims from 2003-2014 for All Health Care Practitioners and MD/DOs Only in Delaware.
